

COVID – 19 Statement 2022 Camping Season

Throughout this pandemic we have followed and continue to follow the guidance and precautionary measure from the CDC and National & State Health Experts to provide and ensure the safety of all persons at Little Mexico Campground. We are taking precautionary measures by sanitizing & disinfecting areas, adding extra cleaning times to our cleaning schedules and limiting hours of operation and the amount of people in certain areas of the campground. Please read the signage and follow directions to ensure your safety and the safety of everyone else. These are all precautionary measures to help with the safety for all persons at the campground.

Here are some measures to follow for a safe camping experience for all.

- Sanitize and or wash your hands often.
- Sneeze and or cough into your elbow or a tissue.
- Camping guest and visitors are free to continue to wear face coverings anywhere on the campground property if they choose to do so.
- If you are sick and or running a fever and or have COVID-19 symptoms, stay at home do not come camping.
- If you have been exposed to COVID-19 within the last 10 days, are awaiting results from a COVID-19 test, or have tested positive for COVID-19 in the last 5 days stay at home do not come camping.
- If you have had COVID-19 and have done the isolation period for the 5 days required and are now released from the required isolation time frame, we require you to wear a mask at all times while on the campground property for your stay for the 10 days following the isolation period.
- Livery services are suspended until further notice.
- All campground facilities will be open for operations and all activities will be operating. Please see our Facebook Page, Campground Newsletter and Posting at our camp store for further information.
- At times we will be closing down some of our amenities for a short period of time to do cleaning and extra sanitation and then re-open the amenity again for you to enjoy.
