

Hello Campers,

Beginning June 5th, 2020, we will be moving into a green zone for the campground and the county where we are established in.

This mean we will have some changes around the campground with rules and regulations and guidelines we must follow.

Below is the detail listing of the rules and regulations and guidelines to now follow while we are under the green zone classification and until we are changed to a different colored zone.

Due to the COVID-19 Virus Outbreak we are taking measures here at the campground to ensure the health and safety of all persons. These measures will begin June 5th, 2020 unless there is further delays ordered by the governor of PA and the rules & regulations and guidelines will be in place until further notice. There is a list of rules & regulations and guidelines we all must follow to keep you & other campers safe and to keep our family and the staff safe. These rules & regulations and guidelines will be in place until further notice and these are rules & regulations and guidelines from the DOH & CDC & OSHA & Govern of PA Office. The only way we can open the campground is by having all of these rules & regulations and guidelines in place and they are followed by all camping guest, or they could possibly shut down the campground until they deem safe for re-opening.

Social Distancing Efforts/Closures/Rules/Regulation/Guidelines & How To Stay Safe:

- Maintain at least 6ft-8ft distance or more away from other people at all times.
- You must wear a mask at all times. You must wear a mask at all times when you are outside and when you are not on your campsite camping. Notices are posted at all places you must wear a mask.
- It is recommended that you do not socialize with other campers on other campsites, to only socialize with your own camping group on your own campsite. You may have other campers visit your campsite but no more than 25 persons may gather at the site at any given time. When other campers are at your site practice safety for all persons, wear a mask and maintain at least 6ft. social distancing.
- No large group and or camper gatherings of any type anywhere in the campground. We have posting of each area and how many people are allowed to be there at any given time. In open areas and field areas of the campground we cannot have no more 50 persons at a time gathering in one area and all persons must wear a mask and maintain at least 6ft social distancing.
- We will now be allowed to have visitors in the campground. All visitors regardless of age must register at the main office/camp store, pay the visitor fee and have a car pass and display it on their vehicle at all times.
- All camping guest must have a car pass displayed on their vehicle at all times while on campground property.
- You may go on walks and ride a bike, but maintain the 6ft distance from others along your path and wear your mask.
- Golf cart usage is now allowed during all hours of the day. All persons on the golf cart must wear a mask at all time while using golf cart. No golf cart driving usage during non-daylight hours. SLOW DOWN! 5MPH! You must follow regular campground golf cart rules in addition to this rule. Your golf cart must be registered with campground and you must have insurance on golf cart with proof provided to the office and golf cart waiver filled out.
- Do not go into any areas and or into any building you do not belong in, they are closed off to the public until further notice. They are posted with signage.
- We will not be providing trash pickup at sites until further notice. You must take your own trash up to the dumpsters for disposal.
- The campground is now open to all classes of reservations (overnights and seasonal) and all classes of campers (cabin, tent, pop-up, travel trailer, fifth wheel, class a/b/c and etc.). All camping guest must follow Campground Rules and COVID-19 Rules.
- No pavilion rentals will be allowed until further notice. Unless you have a group, reservation booking of campsites around the pavilion. Then you may use the pavilion and you must keep the limit of people below 50 persons gathering at any given time and everyone must wear mask while in the pavilion and all persons must maintain the 6ft social distancing.
- No livery service will be available until further notice.

- All children 9yrs of age and under must be with their parent and or legal guardian that is at least 18yrs of age and older at all times. Please make your children that are 10yrs to 17yrs old aware of the rules and that must they follow the rules. Parents are responsible and accountable for their children and their actions at all times.
- If you need to cough and or sneeze, do it into the inside of your arm in the elbow area.
- Wash your hands with soap & water and or use hand sanitizer as much as possible.
- Don't touch everything, keep your hands to yourself and your stuff.
- Clean all touchable surface as much as possible to keep them clean and germ free.
- Do not talk and or engage with the employees or the camp workers while they are out working. They are not here to assist you, help you or get things for you. If you have a question and or need assistance please call or text or 570-374-9742 during store open hours or 570-939-4473 during store closed hours. At this time, we cannot and will not assist any of our campers unless it's absolutely necessary.
- If you are sick, feeling ill or running a fever DO NOT COME TO THE CAMPGROUND! STAY HOME! This applies to all camping overnight reservation guest. IF YOU ARE COVID-19 POSITIVE AND OR COVID-19 SUSPECTED AND OR HAVE BEEN EXPOSED TO SOMEONE ELSE THAT IS COVID-19 POSITIVE AND OR COVID-19 SUSPECTED DO NOT COME TO THE CAMPGROUND, YOU CANNOT QUARANTINE HERE.
- When coming to the campground try to bring as many of your own items as possible and do as much shopping as possible at your home store. This is to limit usage of local stores in our area and community.

It you are caught and or reported in for breaking any of the regular campground rules and or any of the new rules pertaining to the COVID-19 Virus Outbreak you will immediately be evicted from the campground without any refund and be reported to the state police for further handling

These areas will have postings with information of limits and rules pertaining to the COVID-19 efforts and Rules. We will be increasing our cleaning and sanitizing efforts through the campground to help with combating the COVID-19 virus. At times we will be closing down some of our amenities for a short period of time to do cleaning and extra sanitation and then re-open the amenity again for you to enjoy.

CRAFTS – CERAMICS – BINGO – ACTIVITIES

We will have crafts making and ceramics painting available. For craft making we will have a clothing line hanging behind the campground store/office with craft hung up in baggies for the picking. For ceramics painting we will have a table set up in the pavilion with pictures of ceramics for sale and colors of paints to pick from. Campground staff will be there to assist in your selections and give you all your supplies in a baggie for you. You now have the option to take crafts and ceramics back to your site to complete or you may now use the pavilion.

We will be following our current schedule of activities but we will be limiting some of the activities and some will be cancelled.

We will have bingo playing available. We will be conducting our bingo in our main pavilion. We be spacing out our tables and marking some as non-useable. You may also bring your own lawn chairs to sit in the lawn to play or you may use your golf cart, just follow the maintaining the social distancing of 6ft-8ft apart, wear a mask and sanitize your hands. You will not be able to pick out your own bingo cards the campground staff will be doing this for you.

Please look at the information board at the entrance to each side of the campground and information board at the campground store/office for a listing of days & times for craft making, ceramic painting, bingo playing, activities and other campground happenings. - **THE CAMPGROUND STORE/OFFICE WILL BE ON A LIMITED DAYS & HOURS OF SERVICE AND OPERATIONS SCHEDULE UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE. This is to help with our increased cleaning and sanitization efforts.**
- **DURING OUR OPEN HOURS WE WILL ONLY BE ALLOWING 15 PEOPLE IN THE STORE AT A TIME.**
- **YOU MUST WEAR A MASK IN ORDER TO ENTER INTO THE STORE AND IT MUST REMAIN ON THE ENTIRE TIME WHILE IN THE STORE. NO MASK NO ENTRY! NO EXCEPTIONS!**
- **UPON ENTERING THE STORE, YOU MUST SANITIZE YOUR HANDS.**
- **DO NOT TOUCH ANY ITEMS IN THE STORE THAT YOU DO NOT INTEND TO PURCHASE. ONLY TOUCH ITEMS YOU ARE GOING TO PURCHASE.**
- **NO CHILDREN UNDER THE AGE OF 10YRS OLD WILL BE PERMITTED INTO THE STORE UNLESS THEY ARE ACCOMPANIED BY AN ADULT THAT IS 18YRS OLD OR OLDER. AGES 0YRS – 9YRS IS THE AGE GROUP THAT MUST HAVE AN ADULT ACCOMPANY THEM TO ENTER THE STORE.**
